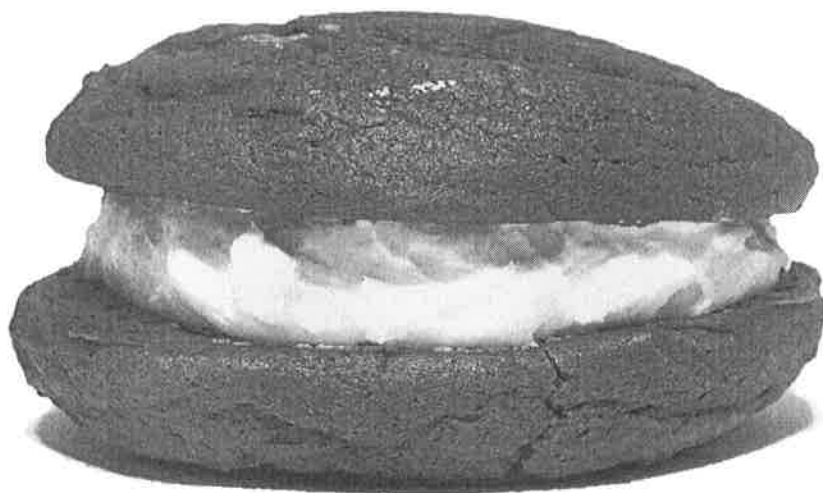
1. All entries must be brought to the Exhibition hall Friday, July 28, 2017 by 6:00 PM.

Category 1 - Traditional Whoopie Pies

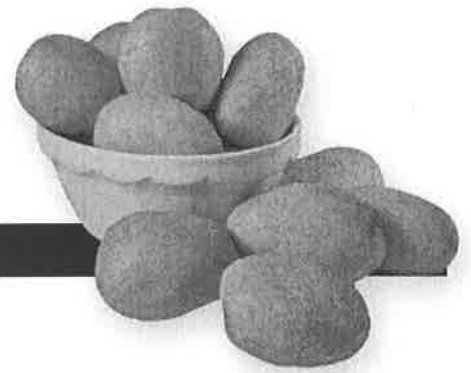
All entries in this category must have the traditional chocolate cakes with white filling.

Category 2 - Flavored Whoopie Pies

This category is for whoopie pies that have either different cakes or filling as compared with the traditional whoopie pie. (ie. pumpkin chocolate chip, lemon etc.)

This year it is time to re-think POTATO SCALLOP. What new styles and flavor can you come up with? All entries will be judged on taste, appearance and most of all CREATIVITY! The entries DO NOT need to be made with new potatoes.

Participation Rules:

1. The entries must be prepared at home and brought to Our County Exhibit hall by 12:00 PM on Saturday July 29. A refrigerator will be available for items that need to be kept cold.
2. The potatoes must be Maine potatoes as the primary ingredient. The potatoes DO NOT need to be new potatoes.
3. The entries should be at least a 9x13 casserole size. One entry per person.
4. All entries will be judged by the public from 12-1 PM.
5. Winners will be announced immediately following the judging.

Who doesn't love a yummy homemade donut, especially with a nice hot cup of coffee? Here in Aroostook County, most of us have a mother or grandmother whose donuts we are sure are the best ever. Here is your chance to see who really does have the bragging rights to be called The Best Donut in The County! And who better to judge donuts than cops? That is right...the contest will be judged by the law enforcing donut connoisseurs of The Presque Isle Police Department.

There are three different categories and contestants are limited to one entry per category. Toppings, icing and trimmings are at the discretion of the contestant (and encouraged by the judges).

Category 1- Traditional Cake donuts

Category 2- Raised (yeast) donuts

Category 3- Filled donuts

Participation Rules:

1. Entries must contain 6 standard size donuts (approx. 3" diameter)
2. Entries must be on a plain white plate.
3. One entry per contestant per category.
4. All donuts will be sold following the judging for \$1 per donut.
5. All entries must be delivered to the Exhibit Hall by 6 PM on Saturday July 29. Judging will begin at 6 PM.

CHILDREN'S CUPCAKE DECORATING CONTEST

This contest will be held in the Agricultural Exhibition Hall Demonstration area and will allow local artists the opportunity to complete their decorations before an audience. All participants must arrive between 2-3 PM on Sunday, July 30. They will then have from 3-4 PM to decorate their cupcakes.

Participation Rules:

1. Two different age classes
 - a. 5-8 yrs (can have 1 adult assistant)
 - b. 9-12 yrs.
2. Each child will be given 6 cupcakes and 1 container of white frosting.
3. Participants may bring any food coloring, decorations, utensils, bowls etc. that they need to prepare their cupcakes.
4. The participants will have 1 hour to decorate their cupcakes LIVE at the Fairgrounds.
5. Registration will be 2-3 PM on Sunday, July 30. The participants will have from 3-4 PM to decorate.
6. The theme for all decorations will be **DOWN ON THE FARM!**
7. The cupcakes will be kept on display at the Fair for the rest of the week.
8. Entries will be judged on the following basis.
 - a. Adherence to theme
 - b. Creativity
 - c. Complexity/techniques
 - d. Neatness and overall appearance

Participation Rules:

1. All parents must be over 18 years of age. The child must be between 6 and 17.
2. Parent is defined as mother, father, grandparent, legal guardian or step-parent.
3. A parent may submit one recipe per child, with a maximum of two entries allowed. Each child may submit only one recipe.
4. The recipe, typewritten or neatly printed on a plain white 4X6 index card, must accompany cookies. No names on the recipes please. All cookies must be submitted on a disposable plate.
5. A minimum of (4) 2"-3" cookies must be submitted.
6. Cookies must be thoroughly cooled.
7. Cookies should be brought to the Agricultural Exhibition Hall between 5-6:00 PM on Monday, July 31. The judging will take place at 6:00 PM.
8. Cookies will be judged on the following criteria.
 - a. Overall appearance 30 points
 - b. Crust 30 points
 - c. Filling 30 points
 - d. Ease of preparation/clarity of recipe 10 points

6. No store purchased chili can be used.
7. For each entry one participant will receive free admission to the Fair.
8. Winners will be based on public judging from 7-8 PM.
9. Entries due from 6-7:00 PM.

5. The pies will be judged at 6 PM.
6. It is strongly recommended to use Maine grown strawberries and rhubarb.

5. The pies will be judged at 7 PM.
6. It is strongly recommended to use Maine grown apples.

The pie in the sky contest is open to any kind of pie for which there is not another contest.

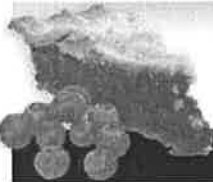
Participation Rules:

6. All pies must be cooled to room temperature.
7. All pies must be in a disposable pie pan.
8. Pies will be accepted on Saturday, August 5 between noon -1 PM. Judging will begin at 1 PM.
9. Pies will be judged on
 - a. Overall appearance 30 points
 - b. Crust 30 points
 - c. Filling 30 points
 - d. Ease of preparation/clarity of recipe 10 points
