All Exhibits must remain on display until Sunday, August 5 at 9:00am

1. Any student enrolled in an Agribusiness, Horticulture, Agri-science, or Forestry Course, in any high school in the County and is a current FFA member is eligible to enroll in this Section. This is FFA, so the individual must have paid current year's dues.
2. Members must select and arrange own exhibit. Parents and advisors may assist.
3. All advisors must fill out and return the Complimentary Pass Request form by Thursday, July 26th to obtain daily passes for any member that will be participating in any FFA events. Request form is located on the last page of the FFA premium book.
3. **Entry forms for all exhibit entries must be turned in to the secretary's office in the Ag Exhibition Building when you arrive with your entries. Tags given to you by the Fair Secretary should be displayed in the lower left hand corner of your item.
5. **Entry forms for FFA Tractor Derby must be handed in to Darick Williams by 8:45am, Tuesday, July 31st or students will not be able to participate in the event.
6. **Entry forms for FFA judging contests must be turned into Kelsey Larabee, FFA Asst. Superintendent no later than 9:25am on Tuesday, July 31st or students will not be able to participate.

5. A class will consist of four FFA exhibits.
6. Five minutes will be allowed for judging.
7. All contestants are requested to refrain from visiting the potato exhibits the morning of the contest.
8. All contestants must pass papers directly to person in charge, as soon as completed.
9. Talking is absolutely prohibited during judging.
10. Time and place of judging to be announced.
11. Potatoes must not be handled.

DIVISION 1.2 – FFA BEEF JUDGING CONTEST- TUESDAY July 31st, 9:45am

CONTEST RULES

1. Contestants must be regularly enrolled pupils in vocational agriculture classes. (Spring graduates O.K.)
2. Teams shall consist of 4 FFA members for beef judging and 4 FFA members for dairy judging.
3. The dairy type judging score card will be used.
4. Four classes will be selected from open classes for judging.
5. A class will consist of four animals.
6. Ten minutes will be allowed for judging each class.
7. All contestants are required to refrain from visiting the dairy and beef exhibits until after the contest.
8. Talking among contestants will be absolutely prohibited during the judging.
9. All other regulations will be the same as those of U. of M. contests at Orono.
10. Placing of animals for scoring papers shall be made by the Official Judge employed by the Fair Association.

NOTE:

1. Potatoes will be displayed in flats and will be of good quality and appearance. Flats should be 14x14, 12x12, or 12x14.
2. Potatoes of like varieties only compete one with the other. Must be free of disease, true to name, and be of commercial value to be entitled to a premium.
3. If in the opinion of the judges, additional entries are worthy, a prize of \$2.00 may be awarded for 4th and 5th place.
4. A person may exhibit as many varieties as he wishes as an individual, but only one person can exhibit from the farm.
5. Any variety not listed will be entered when brought in to the FFA superintendent.

The FFA vegetable exhibits provide members with an opportunity to create a “market display” of crops grown in their garden or farm. Students should select the best quality produce they have to display and incorporate them into a creative display that will enhance their appeal to possible consumers.

1. FFA members may enter vegetables in only one of the three classes of displays.
2. The display tray should be completely utilized.
3. Entries may include non-vegetable items that might enhance the exhibit.
4. A backdrop may be constructed to add to the display, but cannot exceed its width.
5. An index card which identifies vegetable names, varieties, and grower’s name must be displayed in the lower right hand corner of the exhibits.

DIVISION 3.4 – FFA FLORAL DESIGN-JUDGING, – ALL ENTRIES MUST BE BROUGHT IN WEDNESDAY, JULY 25th and/or THURSDAY, JULY 26th BETWEEN 12:00PM AND 8:00PM AND MUST BE LEFT IN PLACE UNTIL 9:30 A.M. SUNDAY, AUGUST 4, 2018. Judging will take place during FFA DAY ON JULY 31st.

FFA Floral Design Theme – “Under the Harvest Moon”

The object of the contest is to produce a design on a flat 18" square board. The arrangement must be stable enough to withstand possible movement of the display boards.

Artificial flowers can be expensive; the cost has nothing to do with your ability to win. One can still collect their own natural material and keep the cost to an absolute minimum. How you use the material is the important factor.

1. Designs themes will be chosen by the NMF FFA Superintendent.
2. The arrangements may not be more than 24" tall and 18" wide. The arrangements will be visible from all sides.
3. The painted board color must not be altered. The board must not be damaged. Thumb tacks, pins, scotch tape, staples are permitted, but leave it clean when finished. You can make your own board.
4. The design must be in place by 8 p.m. Thursday, July 26 and remain on display until 9:30am Sunday, August 5.
5. You may use any material, but it must be permanently dry, no green or decaying material, and no water.
6. An appropriate accessory, art figure, or object, to complement your arrangement, may be used if you wish, but it's the floral design that's important.
7. No auxiliary lighting or electrical connections will be allowed.
8. The contest judge may disqualify an entry if it does not meet the design requirements and they feel that the discrepancy provides an unfair advantage.
9. The FFA superintendent may disqualify designs of unworthy quality and not allow them to be exhibited.
10. Judging will take place on Friday, July 27. Arrangements not meeting all of the requirements will be disqualified and the remaining arrangements will be judged.
