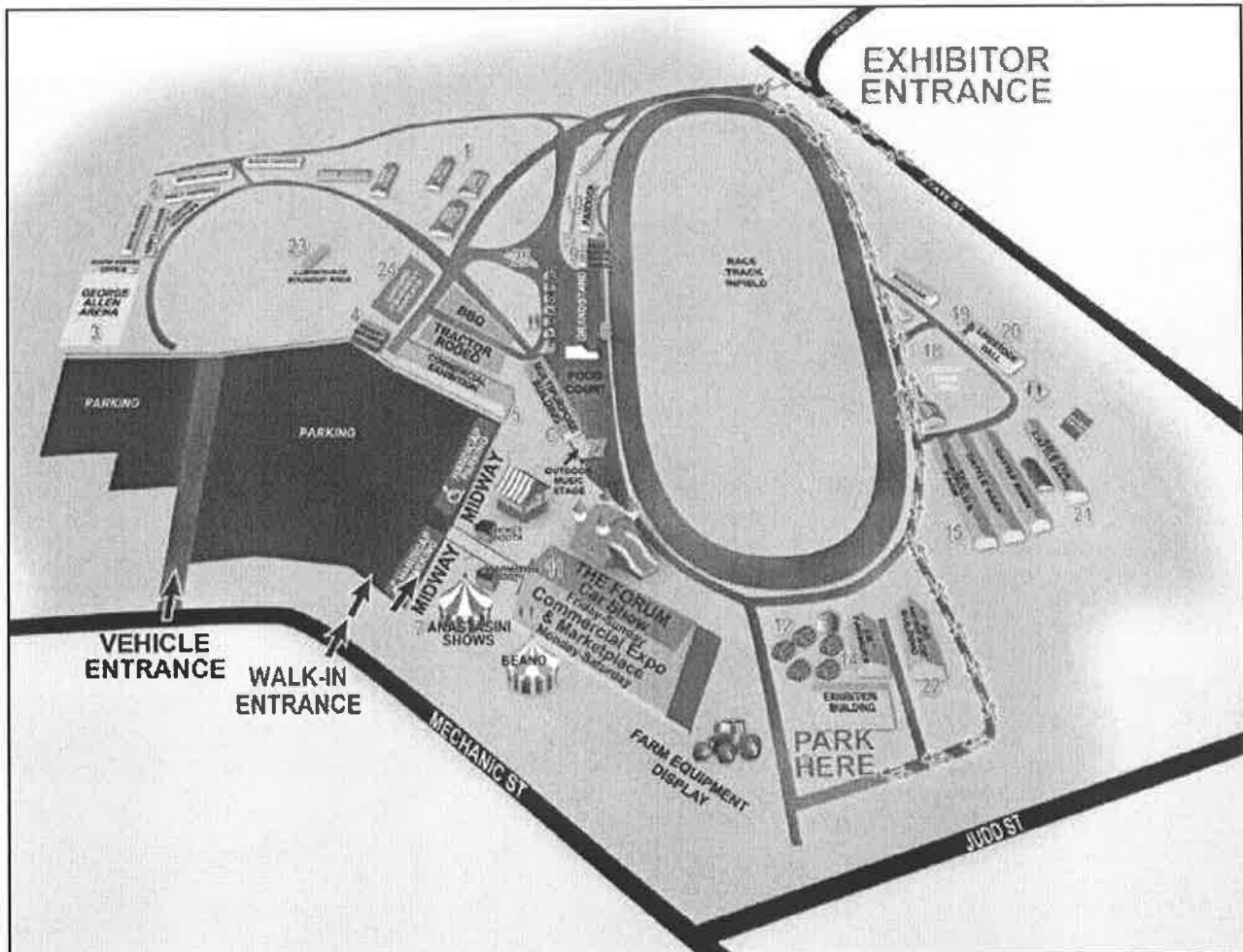


EXHIBITION HALL DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FOLLOWING CONTESTS:

NOTICE:

1. In case of a dispute, or misunderstanding, in any class of cooking, the decisions of the Judges and/or Superintendent of the Cooking Dept., will be considered fair, impartial, and final. All items are entered under these conditions.
2. All cooking must be displayed on paper plates.
3. All items must be fully cooled and wrapped in plastic wrap. No wrapping will be allowed inside the exhibit hall.
4. Breads, both yeast and quick, may be entered as either full loaves or mini loaves. All other items should be regular sized.
5. All items must be made from scratch - no use of mixes.
6. Items will not be returned to the exhibitor.
7. 6 items = 1 entry for cookies, rolls, brownies, squares, donuts, scones, candy, fudge and cupcakes.

FOOD MIXES IN A JAR



Each Category:

1st Prize - \$15 • 2nd Prize - \$10 • 3rd Prize - \$5

Each Entry Must Include:

1. Mix in non-tinted glass jar with secure cover. Jar may not exceed 1 quart size.
2. Recipe on a card.
3. Prepared recipe for judging. 6 items (cookie, cake, muffins) or 2 cups (soups, dips).
4. Decorative Tag. Tag should include the name of the mix.

Rules:

1. No tinted jars
2. No fresh ingredients in jars
3. All jars must NOT require refrigeration. (the prepared recipe may require refrigeration and must be stored properly required to delivery)
4. Date of preparation and storage instructions must be included with prepared item.
5. Jars will be on display during the Fair.
6. The Northern Maine Agricultural Fair reserves the right not to display jars.
7. The recipes do not need to be original but the original sources must be listed. Additional points are awarded for original recipes.
8. The recipe must accompany the entry and every ingredient must be listed with exact measurement (no rounded measurement) and the type of ingredient (example, self-rising flour) must be specified. Follow general proper recipe procedures, listing all steps of preparation, pan sizes, temperature and baking time. Entries will be marked down for incomplete recipes.

Judging:

50% Prepared Item: Taste, Appearance, Originality

50% Mix in Jar: Presentation including assembly of ingredients (layering), color of ingredients, decoration of the jar/creativity, overall presentation

Everyone loves popcorn! How do you make yours? Enter your favorite recipe...Caramel, chocolate, taco, cheese or other new combinations!

Each Category:

Each Entry must include:

1. One quart of flavored popcorn in a re-sealable zipper storage bag.
2. One quart of flavored popcorn in a glass non-tinted lidded jar for display.
3. Complete recipe on card.

Rules:

1. Must not require refrigeration.
2. Must be edible. Popcorn must be fully popped.
3. Date of preparation must be included.
4. Jar or popcorn will be displayed during the fair.
5. The Northern Maine Agricultural Fair reserves the right to not display entered items for the entire duration of the Fair.
6. The recipes do not need to be original but the original sources must be listed. Additional points are awarded for original recipes.
7. The recipe must accompany the entry and every ingredient must be listed with exact measurement (no rounded measurement) and the type of ingredient (example, self-rising flour) must be specified. Follow general proper recipe procedures, listing all steps of preparation, pan sizes, temperature and baking time. Entries will be marked down for incomplete recipes.

HAVE YOUR MAPLE SYRUP JUDGED AT THE FAIR



Prizes: 1st Prize - \$20 • 2nd Prize - \$15 • 3rd Prize - \$10

Rules:

1. All Entries must be produced in the past year by the person entering the contest.
2. Maple Syrup entries must be submitted in an 8 oz clear container for judging and display. No Names should be on the containers.
3. Contestants must also provide a 4 oz container of the syrup for tasting.
4. All entries must be identified appropriately with sugarbush name, producer name, address and syrup grade, by means of a sticker or tag that can be placed next to the container after judging.
5. Only one entry per person per category will be accepted.
6. No points given for decorative containers, ribbons etc.
7. Judge participants may not participate in the contest.

Judging:

There are four criteria used in judging the quality of maple syrup. These are density, color, clarity, and flavor. The score includes: 30 points for density, 20 points for color, 10 points for clarity, and up to 40 points for flavor – for a total of 100%.

Before judging begins, samples of syrup should be shaken to equalize density throughout the sample and mix up any sediment.
