### Participation Rules:

1. The design should be made to fit on a shelf or mantle **8"x24"**.
2. Materials used may be anything-permanently dry i.e. silk flowers, natural dry weeds and seeds etc. Materials need not be costly. It is the arrangement that is important not the cost of the materials.
3. The color of the display area may not be altered.
4. Thumbtacks, pins, scotch tape, staples are permitted. (Leave the area clean when you pick up your arrangement).
5. Accessories are permitted but it is the floral arrangement that is important. Do not use valuable containers or accessories that you would not wish to lose.
6. Removal of any portion of the exhibit before the end of the fair will result in disqualification, loss of premiums, prizes and placings.
7. Judging will take place on the first day of the fair. **Arrangements not meeting all of the requirements will be disqualified and the remaining arrangements will be judged.**
8. Exhibits not picked up by noon on Sunday, July 7th, will become the property of the Northern Maine Agricultural Fair. 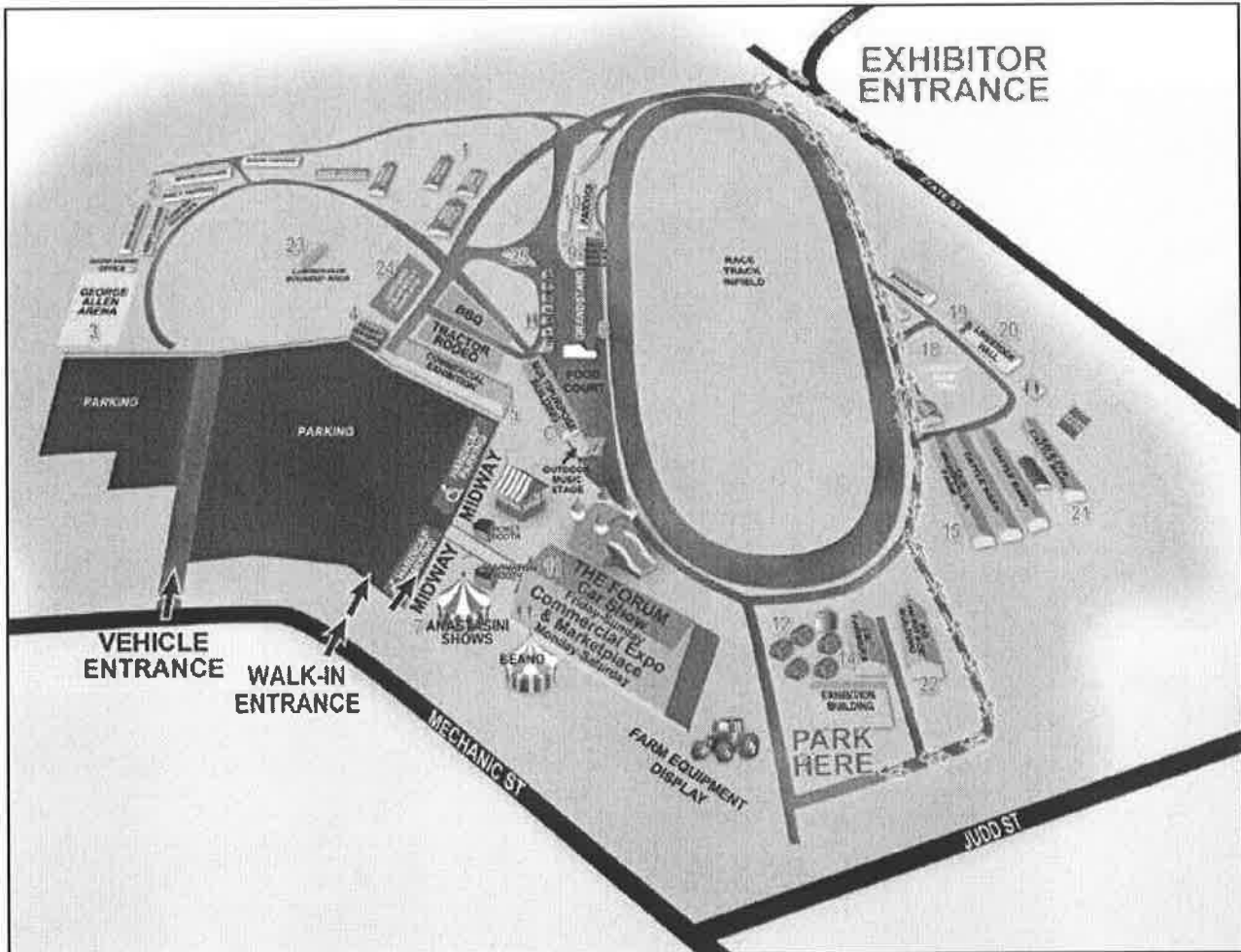
