## GENERAL RULES

1. This event is a New England Lumberjack Association (NELA) sanctioned event and will follow the NELA format and rules.
2. All contestants must be members of NELA. *(Exception will be made for local amateur competitors that only compete at the Northern Maine Agricultural Fair.)*

4. Pre-Registration is required to ensure enough wood is available for chopping and sawing events. You may pre-register at: [www.northernmainefair.com](http://www.northernmainefair.com) and click on the contests / premiums tab.
5. Registration begins at 8:00 AM. Axe throw prelims start at 9:00 AM.
6. Age limit: 16 or older.
7. Judges may limit entries on the basis of wood supply.
8. Contestants must furnish their own tools.
9. Ties will be broken by competing again (money positions only).
10. Decisions of the judges shall be final in all matters pertaining to these contests
11. All chainsaw contestants will be required to wear eye protection, leg protection, and hearing protection.
12. Contestants competing for "All Aroostook Logger" must show proof of residence.

## CONTESTS

### 001) Horizontal chopping Sponsored by Maine Woods Company

Contestants will be judged on the time it takes to cut completely through a timber.



### 002) Women's Horizontal chopping

### 003) Axe Throwing Sponsored by North Maine Woods

The Axe Throw will be bracketed with the top eight men and top eight women from the prelims. Refer to NELA rules for more information.



### 004) Women's Axe Throwing Sponsored by Chadwick - Baross



### 005) Pulp Throwing Sponsored by Milton CAT

Each contestant will have a stick of pulpwood to be thrown. Judging to be for the longest distance. Contestants throwing pulpwood landing outside boundary lines will be disqualified.



### 006) Women's Skillet Throwing Sponsored by Huber Engineered Wood



### 007) Single Buck Sponsored by

Contestant will be judged on the time it takes to cut one block from a 16"-19" white pine log using a crosscut saw. The contestant will be given a 12 inch starter cut to start with.

### 008) Women's Single Buck Sponsored by Freightliner of Maine, Inc.



### 009) Crosscut Saw Sponsored by Seven Islands Land Co.

Contestants will be judged on time it takes them to cut off (2) blocks from a timber.



### 010) Vertical Chop Sponsored by Portage Wood Products Rules same as Horizontal Chop



### 011) Bucksaw Sponsored by Huber Engineered Woods

Contestants will be judged on the time it takes them to cut block from a timber.

### 013) Women's Stock Chain Saw

#### *Sponsored by Moosewood Millworks*

This event is a women's only event. Contestants will make (2) cuts from a timber within lines premarked, using a stock chainsaw. Saws may not be altered in any way. (Stock) Saws must be on the ground and running. Chainsaw will be provided.



### 014) Log Rolling

#### *Sponsored by Irving Woodlands*

Two person teams will use peavey or cantdogs to propel the log by any means. The log shall be rolled from two starting stakes to two stakes 30 feet away and back again to the starting points. The log must touch all four stakes. If the log rolls over boundary lines, the team will be disqualified. No part of the contestant's body may touch the logs.



### 015) Open chain saw, including modified

#### *Sponsored by Frank Martin Sons*

Contestants will make (3) cuts from a timber. Cuts must be made between lines placed by judges. Saws must be on the ground and not started until the "go" signal.



### 016) Tea Boiling

#### *Sponsored by Prentiss & Carlisle*

Each contestant will have (5) matches, a block of dry wood, and his/her axe. Disqualification will result if wood is chopped before the signal go. This event is limited to 30 participants.



### 017) Overall Logger

#### *Sponsored by STIHL*

Will be determined by the number of points each contestant has received.

1st place = 6 points      4th place = 3 points

2nd place = 5 points      5th place = 2 point

3rd place = 4 points      6th place = 1 point

\*\* In the event of a tie, the contestant with the fastest times in each event will win.



### 018) All-Aroostook Logger

#### *Sponsored by Daigle & Houghton*

Will be determined the same as (17) but contestant must be from Aroostook County. Proof of residence required.



### 019) Women's Overall Logger

#### *Sponsored by Northeast Pellets*

Awarded to the woman that places the best overall.
