

Northern Maine Agricultural Fair – Tuff Truck Competition

Side by Side Heet Racing

August 8, 2021 - 4:00PM (During the Demolition Derby)

Prizes: 1st Place - \$400 2nd Place - \$300 3rd Prize - \$200

Rules

1. All Drivers must be 18 years of age or older
2. Helmets and seat belts must be worn by all drivers
3. All glass (except windshield) must be removed as well as all interior materials headlights taillights and all loose material from exterior
4. Only one person in vehicle during a race
5. Gas tank, battery and driver's seat must be securely mounted
6. Any car, truck, SUV, or minivan allowed
7. No alcohol or drugs allowed in pits - any driver or crew member suspected of being under the influence will be removed from the event
8. All vehicles are subject to tech inspection (tech has final say and techs decisions are final)
9. Roll bars or cages recommended not required

GENERAL RULES FOR TUFF TRUCK COMPETITION:

1. Each vehicle may only be entered into competition one (1) time per event. Each driver may enter only one time per class.
2. All contestants must sign a waiver understanding that they are competing at their own risk and that they will not bring suit against any officials, employees, event sponsors or the Northern Maine Fair. By signing the release form you agree to all rules set.
3. Northern Maine Fair officials have the right to approve or reject any or all entry applications.
4. Entry fee will be \$25.00. per vehicle per class.
5. Entry forms will be available the day of the event. Contact Brandon Smith @ 227-8090 for early entry forms or visit www.northernmainefair.com. Sign up early, entries will close one hour before session is scheduled to start. Registration begins at 4 PM.
6. All vehicles must pass tech inspection before competing. If the officials determine a vehicle is unsafe, officials have the right to not allow vehicle to compete. **TECH INSPECTION AREA CLOSSES ONE HOUR BEFORE SESSION IS SCHEDULED TO START.**
7. All drivers must attend driver's meeting unless approved by track officials.
8. A competitor may be disqualified for any reason. Drivers will be held responsible for the actions of their crew). **LIMIT 2 PEOPLE PER PIT CREW.**
9. If any vehicle and/or driver are disqualified for any reason, no refund of entry fee or pit fee will be given. **DRIVER ENTERS FAIRGROUNDS FREE.**
10. Competition vehicles must be operated in a safe manner at all times within the confines of the track, pit area, and staging areas. Track officials have the right to stop and disqualify any vehicle being operated in a reckless manner. Pit and staging areas speed limit is 5 mph.
11. Competitor must wait for the green flag from Starting Flagman before starting the run. Competitor must stop immediately upon signal from the red flag displayed by the Flagman.
12. Only the driver will be allowed in the vehicle when it is being towed or driven in the pit area, staging area or track. No riders in or on any vehicle while in the pit area, staging area, or in the track area.
13. When Competition vehicle's engine is running, a competent driver must be in the driver's seat. No exceptions. **AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION!**
14. Track officials will have the option to check competitors for rule violations at any time during the event.
15. All contestants must drive vehicle onto track and into position to compete under its own power and must leave track under its own power unless for breakage.
16. No one allowed on track except for track officials and contestant.
17. Fuel: pump gas only. All forms of nitro are illegal as a fuel or additive. Nitrous oxide or accelerators are not permitted. No nitrous oxide allowed. Diesel fuel permitted in diesel engines.
18. Recommended that all vehicles carry a dry chemical fire extinguisher.
19. Seat belts (lap belt and shoulder strap) required and must be worn.
20. All vehicles must have a brake system in good working condition.

21. Helmet must be worn with strap fastened.
22. Vehicles must have original firewall and floor in original location. Only holes allowed are those for brakes, clutch, transmission controls and wiring. If battery is relocated it must be in a plastic battery box securely mounted.
23. Hubcaps and wheel covers must be removed before competing. No split rims allowed.
24. No loose objects in cab or any place else in vehicle.
25. Engines must be in original location as intended by the manufacturer.
26. All pickup truck beds must be firmly attached to the chassis. Tailgates must be securely fastened or removed.
27. Stock fuel tanks in stock locations are highly recommended.
28. There must be a bar or chain welded or bolted to the top of the roof and top of the dash area, in the center of the windshield.
29. Contest will be governed by track officials with all decision's final.
30. Track officials reserve the right to change any safety rules if they feel it is necessary.
31. NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM PUBLICATIONS OF OR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES AND/OR REGULATIONS. They are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator, or official. Track officials shall be empowered to permit restrictions that in his opinion do not alter the minimum acceptable requirements. NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH ALTERATION OF SPECIFICATIONS. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the officials. Their decision is final.
